MINUTES OF LAST MEETING	All govs have received minutes from 8.6.20, these were approved.	
Re-opening of school	Last Wed, Cheshire East gave the go ahead for the phased reopening of schools going ahead. Our first day has gone smoothly. We had 10 Preschoolers (offering 2 sessions of 12), 2 people changed their minds and stayed away. 16/20 Reception children back in, will be one more tomorrow. In the Y1,2,3 keyworker/vulnerable 'bubble' we had 9 and in the Y4,5,6 keyworker/vulnerable 'bubble' there were 7. All the staff returned today which is helping to settle school. The one-way systems worked well with a bit of guidance. KC, NM and AW have been stationed around the grounds at both ends of the day which has helped the flow of traffic! This will continue all week, as it is a positive way to message the importance of adhering to allotted drop off and pick up times, and to iron out any problems straight away. KC will write to parents this evening, reiterating this.	
Cleaning	Louisa Jones has resigned her post as caretaker with CrystalClean as she has obtained a full-time position as Teaching Assistant at Beechwood school. Dave Miller is her replacement, joining us from 8 th June. He has made a good start, been busy around school, with Crissy helping to settle him in with rhythms and routines. Crissy is making sure we adhere to the COVID requirements with chemicals etc. GV (cleaner) off but DM being redeployed from OOSC to do some cleaning before and after lunch.	
Banners COVID19	We have ordered signs and banners re social distancing from a local company which have been put up, they look good professional.	
Appeals	These took place on 4 th June via Zoom with an independent panel. Two families appealed the decision, one family withdrew their appeal after reading the school's response statement; the other appeal was heard by the independent panel who rejected their appeal based on school having correctly applied our admissions oversubscription criteria plus the infant class size.	
September opening?	Still unsure on arrangements at this stage, not speculating to parents until we know.	
Q - Financial impact of COVID	There have been changes in timescales for setting next year's budget due to schools' shutdown. KC and KH will look at the budget tomorrow. We expect some areas of extra spending and some savings. We may be able to claim back for extra COVID expenditure.
