With a new term comes a brand new topic. Over the next term, we will be exploring everything space. It promises to be an exciting and engaging topic. I can't wait to get started!

### English

We will continue with our Talk4Writing journey that we started in the Autumn Term. We will plan, write and edit a range of texts together. This term will see us learn new SPaG devices, writing styles and a chance to practise and perfect our handwriting. We will also continue to focus upon reading comprehension and use our phonics to help us with our spellings

### Maths

Power Maths will once again underpin our mathematical learning this year. This term will see us take on multiplication and division, statistics, fractions and measurement. Bring it on!

### Science

## History
