Pick up arrangements

Please try to ensure you are only on the school site during this slot time and follow the signs showing you the one way system. Once you have dropped/collected your child please do not stay on site. What do I need to bring into school?

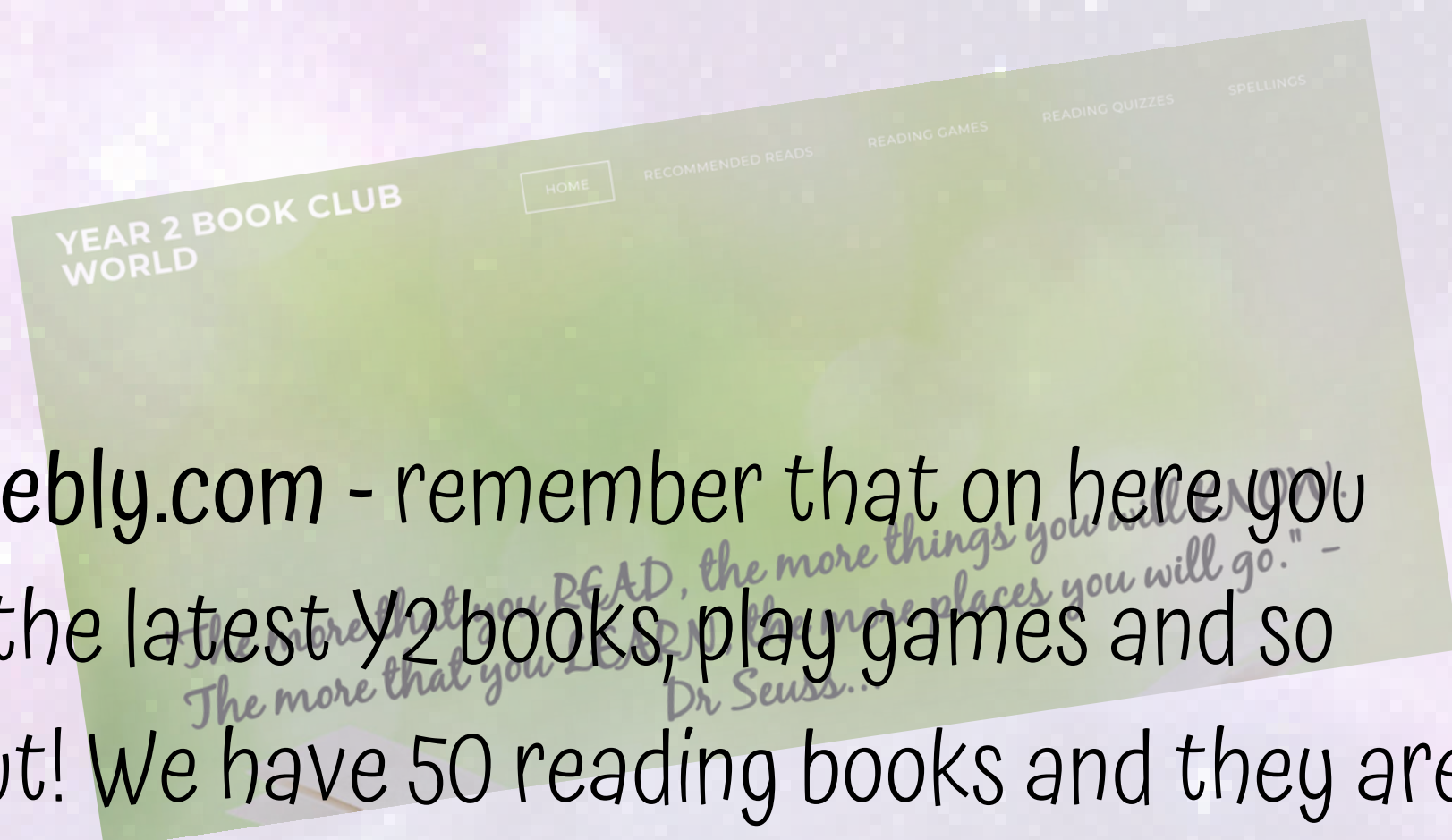
This has to be limited due to the potential for virus transmission. Children are not to bring 'extras' to school. We are asking for no bags, just a plastic book wallet and snack to be in coat pocket or wipeable or disposable lunchbox. Our PE lessons this term will take place on a Tuesday afternoon and will be taught by Mrs Jenkins. Children are asked to come into school in their PE kits on the day that it is being taught. If there is a change to the day that PE will be taught that week, you will receive an email to notify you. Children's PE kits should consist of a Wybunbury Delves blue PE top or plain white t-shirt with no logos or prints, black shorts, white or black trainers, black tracksuit / joggers (essential for PE during winter months) and a Wybunbury Delves black PE hoodie.
