Homework

Homework will continue to be set each Friday. I encourage you to complete all your homework fully and on time. I use homework to consolidate your learning and to enable you to prepare for a new week. Homework will be checked and re-visited each week. Maths.co.uk, or Power Maths, or Spag.com online homework will be set every week. If you are unable to complete these tasks at home, or if you need support, please let me know and I will arrange for you to complete them in school. Regular reading at home and times tables practice will also be included in your weekly homework - TT Rockstars continues to be a successful way to practice your times tables.

Reading

Regular reading out loud at home will continue to be included in your weekly homework. Please could you record each read by filling in each box in your reading diary. Remember to fill in the comment box as I like to read about your thoughts on your book. Our two-week rolling programme will be in place. This means that you will read with an adult each fortnight in Year 4. Remember, we also have our new Year 4 reading challenge which includes lots of great books which are waiting to be read. Research states that if you read for 20 minutes a day at home, you will hear 1.8 million words every year. Amazing!

Our PE lessons this term will take place on a Wednesday afternoon this term and will be taught by Mrs Jenkins. Year 4 will also have Sportscape PE lessons on a Tuesday afternoon. Children are asked to come into school in their PE kits on the days that it is being taught. If there is a change to the day that PE will be taught that week, you will receive an email to notify you. Children's PE kits should consist of a Wybunbury Pelves blue PE top or plain white t-shirt with no logos or prints, black shorts, white or black trainers, black tracksuit / joggers (essential for PE during winter months) and a Wybunbury Pelves black PE hoodie. We will also be continuing with the Paily Mile so please ensure you have trainers in school to change into.

Music

Year 4 will be participating in a brass instrument lesson provided by Music For Life. You will all be learning how to play a musical instrument for free! I think this is an amazing experience and I can't wait for you to start learning. You will all be learning how to play a brass instrument. Cach of you is going to be given your own instrument at the start of the term.

Year 4 Times Table Check

Throughout the Autumn Term, Year 4 have been taking part in Times Table tests and activities. The Multiplication Tables Cheek (MTC) is a key stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of year 4 (in June). The purpose of the cheek is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It is an on-screen cheek consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual cheek. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the cheek should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete. As a school, we are continuing to support the learning of Times Tables. We also ask that you do the same at home. Please continue your support your child to learn their Times Tables and access Times Table Rockstars as much as possible.

I am really looking to continuing our Year 4 journey and seeing what this term has in store for us all. I want to thank you all for your continued support in Year 4.
